VILLAGE OF GLENCOE AND LAKESHORE RECYCLING SYSTEMS WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM TRANSITION

Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS) is honored to expand our partnership with the Village of Glencoe. Beginning **November 1, 2017**, LRS will start service as the exclusive residential waste hauler for the Village in addition to being the current recycling service provider.

As part of this transition, you have the opportunity to select service levels and choose your preferred waste cart size during the selection period (now through October 16). Your selections may be submitted three ways: through mailing the attached perforated postcard back to LRS, using the online portal or by calling us at **773.685.8811**.

WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM TRANSITION

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2018

Starting **April 1, 2018**, LRS is offering weekly yard waste and food scrap collection services, which can be paid for by individual households through an optional annual subscription (\$125) or through the use of stickers which will continue to be sold at Village Hall and the Grand Food Center for **\$2.25** each. Yard waste generally includes leaves, grass cuttings, twigs, small shrubbery clippings, plants and flowers. To participate place your yard waste and/or food scraps at the curb in biodegradable paper bags or containers on Wednesdays. Note that yard waste and food scraps can be combined in the same bag or container. LRS will also collect bundled brush and tree branches of 4-inch maximum diameter and 4-foot maximum length. If using the sticker program, one sticker is required per bag, container or bundle of brush/branches whereas collection is unlimited for annual program subscribers.

HARDSHIP PROGRAM

LRS and the Village of Glencoe will work together to provide a hardship program for those physically unable to bring their waste to the curb. Visit villageofglencoe.org/garbage to learn if you qualify for this program.

SELECTING YOUR WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE OPTION CURBSIDE OR TOP-OF-DRIVE

There are four service options available to Glencoe residents: **curbside** and **top-of-drive**, either **once** or **two times** per week. These service levels are for waste collection only, as the existing recycling service will remain as curbside collection.

CURBSIDE SERVICE requires that the waste cart is brought to a location adjacent to the street pavement.

TOP-OF-DRIVE SERVICE requires the cart or can placed adjacent to the residential dwelling or just outside the garage door. The LRS driver will move the container to the truck and back for proper collection service.

These fees are inclusive of waste and recycling collection, fall leaf collection and two additional annual clean-up days in the spring and fall.

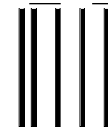
