**City of St. Charles 2020 Spring Clean Up Program is Canceled**  
*Cancellation due to COVID-19 Safety Practices*

**ST. CHARLES, Ill.** (May 5, 2020) – The City of St. Charles 2020 Spring Clean Up program originally scheduled for June is canceled. The program allows residents to place unwanted items at the curb for pick up.

Lakeshore Recycling Systems, the vendor that conducts the program, halted collection of bulk items to limit employee exposure to the coronavirus (COVID-19), which the Centers for Disease Control suggests can last on some hard surfaces for many days.

The City will continue to follow State and Federal health and safety guidelines related to the COVID-19 virus to evaluate Spring Clean Up in the future.
