NO-BAKE CHOCOLATE PUDDING PIE

No need to turn on the oven with this recipe! This chocolatey dessert is simple to make and takes 1 hour!



INGREDIENTS

- 1 box 5.85 oz instant chocolate pudding
- 1 pre-made 9 inch graham cracker pie crust
- 1 8 oz tub whipped cream
- 1 regular sized Hershey's Chocolate Bar
- 2% milk as called for on pudding box

INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare your instant chocolate pudding per package directions (different brands require different amounts of milk).

1. Pour a little less than half of your chocolate pudding into the bottom of your graham cracker pie crust.
2. Mix the remaining pudding with 1/2 of the whipped cream and stir well.
3. Add as the next layer of pie.
4. Add 1/2 of the remaining whipped cream to the top of the pie.
5. Using a potato peeler shave off chocolate pieces to add to the top of your pie.
6. Refrigerate for 1 hour (or more) Serve and enjoy!

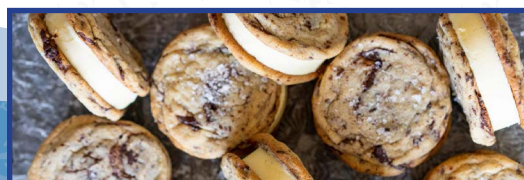

RECIPE OF THE WEEK

LAYERED ICE CREAM SANDWICH CAKE

Want to have a super impressive dessert that's easy to make? This ice cream sandwich cake is layers of ice cream sandwiches, whipped topping and candy, all stacked up to form pure deliciousness!



INGREDIENTS

- 12 ice cream sandwiches unwrapped
- 16 ounces whipped topping thawed
- 1/2 cup miniature chocolate chips
- 3/4 cup of M&M's
- 1/3 cup fudge sauce or desired amount

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place 4 ice cream sandwiches in a row on a serving plate.
2. Use a piping bag fitted with a large star tip to pipe dollops of whipped topping over the ice cream sandwiches.
3. Sprinkle chocolate chips and M&M's over the layer of whipped topping.
4. Freeze until firm.
5. Repeat the process with the remaining ice cream sandwiches, whipped topping and candies until you have 3 layers of ice cream sandwiches and 3 layers of whipped topping and candies. Freeze each layer until firm before proceeding with the next layer.
6. Freeze the whole cake until firm, at least 1 hour.
7. Drizzle the fudge sauce over the top of the cake. Cut into slices then serve.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Cake can be stored in the freezer for up to 3 days before serving. For storage, cover the cake loosely with plastic wrap once cake is completely firm or store in a container that will fit the cake.
