## VILLAGE OF WESTERN SPRINGS

NEW REFUSE, RECYCLING AND YARD-WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS) is excited to become the Village of Western Springs' new waste and recycling hauler as of January 1, 2020. We know that Village residents have high expectations when it comes to service, quality and value; we intend to exceed those standards.

With the Village's new hauling agreement, residents will notice a cost-savings, as well as an improvement in service options and enhanced uniform curbside appearance.

With the transition occurring from Republic Services to LRS on January 1, 2020, residents should avoid buying large amounts of Republic stickers. However, LRS will accept Republic stickers through the month of March.

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

- Residents should decide which size refuse and recycling carts you would like to use. Sample carts
  are available at Village Hall, the WS Recreation Center, and the train station. Residents who do not
  make a cart selection before November 27 will recieve 65-gallon waste and recycling carts.

#### GARBAGE AND RECYCLING CARTS

With the transition to an all-cart program, Western Springs residents will notice not only a savings in the cost of service and stickers, but also an improvement in curbside appearance on service days allowing for cleaner streets and more efficient service.

Carts will be delivered starting on December 15, 2019, and continue through December 30, 2019. All carts will be delivered at curbside, and should not be used for service until January 1, 2020.

On service days, residents who are new to the cart format should plan on having carts out for service by 7AM. Carts should be placed at least 3' from mailboxes, trees, light poles or parked cars, and 1' – 2' from the curb or other cart. If you have been using your own garbage can with a sticker, you can either keep that container for your general home needs, or we will take it at no cost – as long as it is labeled "Please take/dispose."



### **GENERAL COLLECTION GUIDELINES**

Your service day will either remain on Tuesday or Friday, or be switched to Wednesday or Thursday. Please call: 773.685.8811 or email: WesternSprings@LRSrecycles.com for verification.

All garbage, recycling and yard waste will be serviced between 7AM and 5PM on collection days. Please have your carts out for service between 7PM the night before service, and 7AM on your collection day. Carts should be removed from the curbside by 7PM on collection days.

## MAIN SERVICES

#### REFUSE (GARBAGE) COLLECTION

If you have additional garbage that will not fit into your cart, you must use a garbage sticker for each bag or item outside of the cart. Stickers can be purchased at Village Hall, or the same vendors that have carried them in the past. There is no limit on the amount of bags that can be collected, as long as each bag has a sticker. Please note: garbage mixed with yard waste / leaves / grass clippings cannot be taken as waste.



#### RECYCLING COLLECTION

Residents can mix recyclable items in their recycling cart. There is no limit on the amount of recyclable material that can be put out for service each week. Excess items that will not fit into recycling carts may be placed on the side of the cart for collection, and will not require a sticker. Residents are encouraged to consider a larger recycling cart to keep pace with the increasing amounts of material that are recyclable, and the advent of on-line purchasing (cardboard-based). Please do not place plastic bags in your recycling cart.

#### YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Between April 1 through November 30, residents should continue to use brown (kraft) bags for yard waste disposal. Each bag will require one sticker. LRS also offers a subscription option, in which residents will be provided a yard waste cart.

Yard waste that will not fit into a brown bag or cart will need to be bundled in units that are no longer than 4' and 18" in diameter. Each stack will require one waste sticker for removal. Yard waste in plastic bags will not be accepted.

# ADDITIONAL SERVICES

#### BULK ITEMS

Bulk items are items that are too large to fit into your waste cart. Each bulk item requires three (3) waste stickers affixed. Carpet rolls may be no longer than 4' and 18" in diameter, and will require three (3) waste stickers. If an item is too large, or an item that is not allowable to take, special arrangements may need to be made.

#### WHITE GOODS

White goods are appliances containing CFC, HCFC, PCBs mercury switches or other hazardous components. Examples: refrigerators, air conditioners and humidifiers. These items will require ten (10) waste stickers to be collected. All white goods will be collected on a separate truck, and will need to be scheduled.

#### DO-IT-YOURSELF CONSTRUCTION

For your more intensive and larger 'Do-it-Yourself' jobs, or general home renovations and clean-outs, LRS offers a range of roll-off boxes – including 10yd, 15yd, 20yd and 30yd sizes. You simply need to call an LRS representative at 773-685-8811 to set up same-day or next-day service

#### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

HHW products are flammable, toxic, corrosive and/or reactive, and can pose a harmful threat or damage to the environment when disposed of improperly. Items like paint, pesticides, poisons, cleaning solvents, old or tainted gasoline, used oil and other automotive fluids are considered to be hazardous, and should not be included with your regular household waste.

#### **ELECTRONIC WASTE**

Under the Village's new agreement with LRS, residents have an ala carte option of properly disposing of electronic waste. This includes: one smaller electronic item, mouse, keyboard, telephone (one sticker); Bundle/ Brown Bag not to exceed 15"x15"x15" (five stickers); Television or Monitor (10 stickers per item)



# RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

## PAPER

Newspaper and inserts Computer printouts Glossy brochures Stationery Envelopes Cardboard boxes Magazines catalogs & phone books
Hanging file folders (remove metal & trash it)
Index cards
Fax paper
Junk mail
Brown paper grocery bags

Office paper notebooks Pastel sticky notes Greeting cards Manila folders Chipboard/Paperboard Paperback books

- Recyclable items must be clean
- NO used paper plates or pizza boxes, or fluorescent paper (they contaminate the paper stream with food, dye, or plastic coating) If pizza box top is clean you can tear it off and recycle it.
- NO paper towels, tissues, or napkins, which are not recyclable because the fibers are too small to reuse (please compost them with kitchen food scraps if possible)
- NO Shredded Paper Loose shredded paper causes major sorting problems in the Recycling Facilities
- NO frozen food boxes, which are made of a hybrid of paper and plastic, and are not wanted by paper mills
- NO paper cups, which are also made of a hybrid of paper and plastic rendering them unrecyclable

#### **ALUMINUM CANS AND FOIL**

## CARTONS

Milk, Soup, and Juice cartons & boxes

#### STEEL/TIN CANS

Food cans and lids Metal paint cans and lids Empty aerosol cans

NO utensils, propane tanks, wire hangers, or small appliances

#### **GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS**

All colors are accepted

NO window or auto glass, bakeware, ceramics, mirrors, light bulbs, coffee pots or drinking glasses

#### PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Plastic bottles Plastic tubs Plastic jugs

- NO plastic bags or plastic film (plastic wraps, sandwich bags, freezer bags, tarps)
- NO plastic utensils or plates (plastic wraps, sandwich bags, freezer bags, tarps), cups, lids or straws
- NO candy wrappers, cereal bags, potato chip bags, or snack bags
- NO empty motor oil, pesticide, or chemical bottles
- NO Styrofoam, polystyrene (do not put in curbside bin)

# WASTE AND RECYCLING CARTS

ALL WESTERN SPRINGS RESIDENTS WILL AUTOMATICALLY RECEIVE NEW LRS REFUSE AND RECYCLING CARTS

#### CART REQUEST PROCESS

- Smaller and larger carts for garbage and recycling are available in 35, 65 and 95-gallon sizes. The cost of the recycling cart is included in your monthly rate regardless of recycling cart size.
- Additional carts are available for \$3.00 each per month for garbage or recycling in 35, 65 or 95-gallon.
   Additional yard waste carts are available for an additional \$6.00 per month in 65 or 95-gallon.
- Please submit your cart request between September 1 and November 27 to receive prior to service.
- No action is necessary for residents who prefer the 65-gallon carts for both garbage and recycling.

Village of Western Springs residents may make a cart request online or by calling LRS Customer Service. Please be sure to make your cart selection between September 1 and November 27 in order to receive the selected cart(s) before the start of service (generally 1-2 weeks prior to service). Republic will continue with pickups through December 31st; LRS will not commence service until January 1, 2020.

#### LRS ONLINE CART SELECTION (SUGGESTED)

Submitting a cart request is very easy with the LRS Online Cart Selection. Requests submitted online are immediately received and processed. You can select from different size carts, additional carts, and yard waste carts. You may also request to receive your invoice by email. LRS recommends residents use the online cart selection.



#### HOW TO SUBMIT SPECIAL CART REQUESTS

#### **KEY SERVICE DATES**

- September 1 November 27: Register and pick your garbage and recycling cart size
- December 15 December 30: LRS will deliver your new carts curbside
- January 1, 2020: LRS will start services in the Village of Western Springs
- January 1 March 31: LRS will accept Republic Services stickers
- January 1 March 31: Carts may be exchanged for different sizes at no charge.

## SERVICE CHANGES

- Stickers will no longer be used for standard weekly waste and recycling pickups.
- Stickers will be used for extra garbage, yard waste, e-waste, bulk items, etc.
- Every home will receive one waste cart and one recycling cart; residents will have the option of using a 35-gallon, 65-gallon or 95-gallon for garbage, and a 35-gallon, 65-gallon or a 95-gallon cart for recycling.
- Residents will now be charged a monthly fee for services, which will be billed quarterly.
- The Village will be serviced on a four-day schedule. An inset map on this mailer will illustrate your possible new pickup day.

# TRANSITION UPDATES



#### LRS HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

LRS observes the following annual holidays.

New Year's Day Memorial Day Independence Day Labor Day Thanksgiving Christmas

There will be no collection on the holiday.

If the holiday falls on a weekday prior to your regular service day, service will be the following day. Services will take place on Saturdays during holiday weeks.

# BILLING AND PAYMENT

Residents will be billed on a quarterly basis, in advance. As a means to be environmentally friendly, we encourage you to pay electronically. For those residents taking advantage of this option, you may choose to pay with an automatic bank draw or via ACH transfer from an account that you authorize.

#### COST INFORMATION

The weekly collection of garbage, recycling and yard waste will be less expensive with the new program. The following side is a list of charges for various cart sizes and services.

## GARBAGE / YARD WASTE STICKERS

Stickers will be needed for yard waste, extra garbage (outside of cart), bulk items and electronic waste. Stickers can be purchased at Village Hall and the same retail outlets at a cost of \$3.00 per sticker.

#### BULK ITEM = 3 STICKERS PER UNIT

White Good = 10 stickers per unit

Electronic Waste = 1 sticker per single (small) item, 5 stickers per bundle within a brown paper bag, 10 stickers per television or monitor.

## **AUTO PAYMENT OPTION**

LRS offers an auto-pay option for residents who choose to establish this method of payment. Once you receive your first invoice from LRS you may choose this option. #### SUSPENSION OF SERVICE

Residents who need to suspend service for one (1) month or longer must notify LRS at least seven (7) days before service is to be suspended. A one-time \$5.00 service interruption will be charged for each service interruption, regardless of length.
