NEW REFUSE. RECYCLING AND YARD-WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS) is excited to become the City of Des Plaines' new waste and recycling hauler, starting on March 1, 2021. We know that the Des Plaines residents have high standards when it comes to service, quality and value; we look forward to exceeding those standards.

Under the City's new contract with LRS, most residents should see a modest decrease in service costs, as well as improved waste, recycling and yard waste service options.

This mailer will include essential information, which will help answer basic questions, and explain your new services in greater detail. We hope you will keep this mailer handy and use it as a reference point as needed.

SERVICE TRANSITION

New service with LRS will start on March 1, 2021. However, we will start delivering carts during the week of February 15th. Carts will be placed at your curbside (your waste and recycling carts may be delivered at different times). A note that directs you not to use your new carts until the first week of March will be attached to the carts as a reminder. The current carts you are using will be removed during the last week of February. Please remember to leave those carts on your parkway after your last service with Republic.



SERVICE DAYS

Your service day will remain the same. On your regular collection day, we ask that you have your carts out for service by 7AM. Carts should be placed at least 3' from mailboxes, and 1' to 2' off the curb.

MAIN SERVICES

WASTE (GARBAGE) COLLECTION

You will be provided one garbage cart by LRS, which will be serviced on a weekly basis. Cart size options: 35-gallon, 65-gallon and 95-gallon (95-gallon will be the default size). One 'bulk' item a week may be placed out for collection at no additional charge. Additional bulk items may be placed out for collection but may result in a service charge.

Additional waste carts may be rented at a cost of \$3.00 per month.



RECYCLING COLLECTION

You will be provided one recycling cart by LRS, which will be serviced on a weekly basis. Cart size options: 35-gallon, 65-gallon and 95-gallon (65-gallon will be the default size). Your recycling service will continue to be defined as single-stream, which means most clean and non-contaminated household items will be considered recyclable. A list of acceptable and unacceptable items is included in this mailer. (Please note: pizza boxes, plastic bags of any kind and textiles / clothing are not acceptable recycling items.)

Residents may place out as much accepted recycling items as they wish each week for collection.

Additional recycling carts may be rented at a cost of \$3.00 per month.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Similar to your waste and recycling service, LRS will provide collection of properly placed yard waste material on a weekly basis. This service is seasonal, and will run from April 1, through the end of November.

All yard waste must be placed in a proper receptacle, not to exceed 50lbs in weight. Paper kraft bags may also be used. User-owned cans should not exceed 35-gallons and should be clearly marked as 'Yard Waste.' Cans and kraft bags that contain excessive amounts of soil, dirt or earth may go uncollected. LRS will also take bundles of sticks, twigs and branches that are no more than 4' in length, and 18" in diameter.

Your yard waste collection day will be the same as your waste and recycling collection day. All items and material should be placed out for collection by 7AM.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES



BULK ITEMS

One 'bulk' item may be placed out for collection each week at no additional cost, 'Bulk' items are defined as items too large to fit into your waste cart, and 50lbs in weight or less. 'Bulk' items do not include 'white' goods (appliances like refrigerators, washing machines, etc) or electronic waste, certain types of construction debris (concrete, stone, masonry etc.), dirt, tree stumps and engines, among other items.

For additional 'bulk' collection outside of the weekly limit of one item, please contact LRS to schedule service. Items will be charged on a per-yard basis.

PIT STOP

WHITE GOODS

"White' goods are generally defined as appliances like refrigerators, washers and dryers, ovens, but include other items as well. LRS will collect these items, but they must be scheduled for collection. There will be a per-unit charge of \$30 per unit.

DO-IT-YOURSELF CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

Up to one cubic yard of construction debris may be placed out for collection each week. Construction debris is defined as basic material that is consistent with household projects, renovations and clean-outs.

ELECTRONIC WASTE

Electronic waste will be collected as part of your quarterly waste and recycling program. It is encouraged that you contact our customer service department to schedule services for these items.

CHRISTMAS TREES

One Christmas tree per household will be collected at no charge during the first two weeks of January. This will include real trees, which need to be free of chemicals, sprays and any decoration.

TRANSITION UPDATES

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

- You will have the option to choose which size of garbage and recycling carts you would like to use. Those sizes are: 95-gallon, 65-gallon and 35-gallon. To choose your cart, you can either call our customer service at 844.NEED.LRS, or register online through our dedicated web portal: LRSrecycles.com/DesPlaines.
- The deadline to register by phone and online is February 5, 2021. Should you choose not to register for a cart, the default sizes will be 95-gallon for waste, and 65-gallon for recycling.

IMPORTANT NOTE: PLEASE LEAVE YOUR REPUBLIC CART(S) ON THE CURBSIDE ON THE LAST DAY OF YOUR SCHEDULED SERVICE.

MISSED COLLECTION PICKUP

Please contact LRS at 844.NEED.LRS to notify LRS Customer Service your waste material was not collected. If you would prefer to email, please send your name, phone number, full address and specifically what material was not collected (garbage, recycle, yard waste, large item, etc.) to Service@LRSrecycles.com.

Improperly prepared materials placed for collection will not be collected. LRS will tag the items left behind for the resident communicating the non-compliance preventing the collection.

BILLING AND PAYMENT

CHANGES IN BILLING

In the past, you have been billed for waste and recycling services through the City's utility bill on a bi-monthly basis. Under the City's new contract, you will be billed on a guarterly basis, directly by LRS.

<u>Recyclable items must be clean</u>

• NO used paper plates or pizza boxes, or fluorescent paper (they contaminate the paper stream with food, dye, or plastic coating) If pizza box top is clean you can tear it off and recvcle it.

• NO paper towels, tissues, or napkins, which are not recyclable because the fibers are too small to reuse (please compost them with kitchen food scraps if possible)

• NO Shredded Paper - Loose shredded paper causes major sorting problems in the recycling facilities

• NO frozen food boxes, which are made of a hybrid of paper and plastic, and are not wanted bv paper mills

• NO paper cups, which are also made of a hybrid of paper and plastic rendering them unrecyclable

CARTONS

Milk, Soup, and Juice cartons and boxes

STEEL/TIN CANS

All colors are accepted • NO window or auto glass, bakeware, ceramics, mirrors, light bulbs, coffee pots or drinking glasses

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Plastic bottles

Plastic tubs NO plastic bags or plastic film (plastic wraps, sandwich bags, freezer bags, tarps) • NO plastic utensils or plates (plastic wraps, sandwich bags, freezer bags, tarps), cups, lids or straws

• NO candy wrappers, cereal bags, potato chip bags, or snack bags

NO empty motor oil, pesticide, or chemical bottles

• NO Styrofoam, polystyrene (do not put in curbside bin)
