## GARBAGE & RECYCLING SERVICE

### COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Garbage, recycling and landscape waste (in season) will be collected Monday through Friday on the designated service day noted on the back of the mailer. All items need to be placed out to the curb by 6 AM. Collection times are subject to change.

### GARBAGE COLLECTION

Residents will automatically be delivered a 95-gallon garbage cart. There is no limit to the amount of garbage LRS will collect. Residents may use a non-LRS cart or container for waste materials that do not fit into the LRS issued cart so long as it does not exceed 32-gallons, 50 lbs. and has two handles. Residents who generate more trash may request an additional 95-gallon trash cart from the City.

### RECYCLING COLLECTION

Residents will automatically be delivered a 65-gallon recycle cart. Residents may use a non-LRS cart or container for waste or recycling materials that do not fit into the LRS issued cart, so long as it does not exceed 32-gallons, 50 lbs. and has two handles. Residents who generate more recyclables may request an additional 95-gallon recycling cart from the City.

## LANDSCAPE WASTE COLLECTION

Landscape waste is collected seasonally from April 1st through December 15th on the same day as garbage and recyclables.

### WHAT IS CONSIDERED LANDSCAPE WASTE?

Landscape waste, also known as yard waste, consists of organic waste materials accumulated as the result of cultivation and maintenance of gardens, lawns, shrubbery, trees and vines.

Landscape waste is garden trimmings, branches and brush under two inches (2") in diameter, leaves, flowers, tree droppings (crabapples and pinecones), garden plants, vines, weeds, grass clippings and yard trimmings.



### APPROVED LANDSCAPE WASTE CONTAINERS OR BAGS

Landscape waste must be placed in approved biodegradable landscape waste bags or open garbage cans not larger than 32-gallon capacity clearly marked "Landscape Waste" or "Yard Waste."

- Kraft bags not exceeding 32-gallons or 50 lbs. when full
- Personal metal or plastic containers not exceeding 32-gallons or 50 lbs. when full
- Bundled yard waste not exceeding 4 feet in length, 24 inches (24") in diameter securely tied with biodegradable string or twine
- Bundles should not exceed 50 lbs. when full

## SPECIAL WASTE COLLECTION

Items requiring additional labor and/or equipment to manage are a Special Refuse Collection. LRS provides special pick-ups or special collections for large amounts of garbage from a move-out or a flooded basement or large clean outs. LRS will provide a cost estimate if we are able to provide the service. LRS does not guarantee collection of every item.

## BULK ITEMS

LRS will collect one (1) bulk item per week, along with your regular garbage at no additional fee. Bulk items are small furniture items or toys that do not fit in the cart. Bulk items must be **prescheduled** to LRS 24 hours before the service day.

Bulk examples include: furniture, mattresses, box springs, toilet, sofas, bicycles, chairs, love seats or large toys

Mattresses and box/bed springs are required to be in a plastic mattress cover and taped securely shut. Plastic mattress covers may be purchased through online retailers such as Amazon, or retail outlets such as Walmart, Lowes, Menards, Home Depot and storage unit facilities.

Please contact Customer Service for any items of which you are unsure.

## APPLIANCE & WHITE GOOD COLLECTION

Some appliances require special handling as they may contain harmful chemicals, or they need to be recycled at a special location.

All appliances/white goods must be **prescheduled** to LRS by calling customer service.
