IMPROVEMENT AND CHANGES TO KILDEER SERVICE

- Every home will receive a new cart on wheels for garbage & recycle
- Additional garbage and recycle carts are available to rent for \$2.50 a cart, per month
- Yard waste sticker and subscription programs

- **June 28th** - Last service day with WM, leave empty WM carts at curb
- **June 30th** - First service day with LRS. Begin using LRS carts, bring to curb by 7 AM
- **July 4th** - Holiday (Friday, July 7th service day will be delayed one day)
- **July 8th** - Service day
- **July 14th** - Return to your new LRS service day of Friday, each week

CART SIZE SELECTIONS & NEW CART DELIVERIES

- Enrollment is only required to receive smaller garbage cart(s) or additional carts
- Deadline to select cart size is **MAY 30, 2023**

- LRS will deliver carts before the start of service



EACH HOME WILL RECEIVE 1 (ONE) 95-GALLON GARBAGE CART AND (1) 95-GALLON RECYCLE CART IF A SECTION IS NOT MADE BY MAY 30, 2023.

FINAL WASTE MANAGEMENT COLLECTION & CART REMOVALS

Leave Waste Management carts at the curb after the final service day to be permanently removed.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

LRS will collect live trees on your normal collection day for no charge during the first two weeks of January. Trees must be free of tinsel, lights and ornaments. Trees must be placed curbside.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Service will be delayed by one day if a holiday falls Sunday through Friday. If the holiday falls on a Saturday, your service day will not be delayed. The following holiday's may impact your service day:

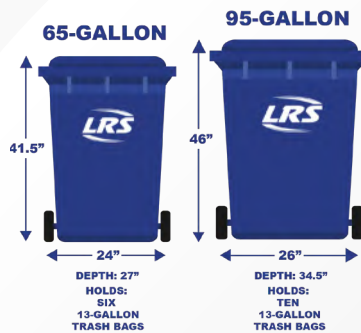

GARBAGE COLLECTION

Beginning June 30, 2023, LRS will be the new service provider for curbside garbage, recycling and yard waste for Kildeer homes. Materials must be placed out by 7 AM on your collection day. **Garbage is collected weekly on the Village's new weekly service day of Friday.** Service times after 7 AM may vary and are subject to change.

LRS provides wheeled carts with a flip-top lid and handlebar to throw your garbage in. LRS garbage carts are 95-gallon in size. Residents may request an additional garbage cart or decrease their size options by submitting an online request or contacting LRS customer service.



- **Option 1** - LRS supplied recycling cart + LRS supplied 95-gallon garbage "unlimited" \$19.95/month
- **Option 2** - LRS supplied recycling cart + LRS supplied 65-gallon garbage "limited" \$19.25/month
- **Option 3** - LRS supplied recycling cart + resident supplied garbage cans "unlimited" \$19.95/month

For seniors requesting the senior discount, please contact Village Hall directly.

(Any additional garbage that does not fit inside the LRS issued cart will require stickers for collection. "unlimited" service may place out to 10 bags with no stickers.)

Please note, LRS and the Village of Kildeer encourages residents to contain all garbage in a LRS supplied cart. Personal containers, are not fully equipt to be lift on the LRS truck automation, LRS is not responsible for any damage to personal containers.

If you chose to utilize your own container. Please follow the guidelines listed below for proper collection:

RESIDENT OWNED CONTAINER GUIDELINES:

- No larger than 95-gallons and 50lbs when full
- Must be clearly labeled "TRASH" or "GARBAGE"

BULK ITEMS

BULK ITEMS are items that are too large to fit into your LRS cart. LRS will collect one (1) bulk item per week for no charge. Items are to be placed alongside your LRS cart.

EXAMPLES OF BULK ITEMS:

Table | Chair | Mattress | Bed Frame | Box Spring | Fixture | Toy | Sofa | Wall Picture

MATTRESSES & BOX SPRINGS must be secured in a plastic mattress cover for health and safety reasons. Mattress covers are available at hardware stores and other retail outlets.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS AND CARPET ROLLS please contact LRS at **844.633.3577** or email Service@LRSrecycles.com with a picture of your item(s) to inquire on a special collection.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

LRS will collect an unlimited amount of recyclables weekly on the Friday service day. The LRS recycle carts are to be used first for placing recyclables out for collection. Carts are available in the 65 or 95-gallon size (standard recycling cart given to each home will be the 95-gallon if no other selection is made). Recyclables and garbage are collected on the same day. Materials must be placed out by 7 AM on your collection day.

ADDITIONAL RECYCLE CART RENTAL

Available in 95-gallon size for \$2.50 a cart, per month billed by LRS. Delivery fees may apply. Submit a request through the cart portal at: LRSrecycles.com/Kildeer.

Most appliances require special handling as they may contain harmful chemicals. All appliances/white goods must be prescheduled and prepaid \$30.00 to LRS by calling or emailing customer service.

ELECTRONIC WASTE DROP-OFF

Electronic waste (E-Waste) are items that are banned from the landfill (cannot go in your normal trash). The items below are not included in your curbside collection and need to be taken to a drop-off location. Two times per year, the Village of Kildeer and LRS will have a secure location for residents to drop materials off Locations and dates are still to be determined. Please contact LRS customer service to learn more.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

According to the EPA, Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) are products that can catch fire, react, or explode under certain circumstances. All HHW items are banned from the landfill and will not be collected with curbside collection. LRS encourages residents to take advantage of the drop-off facilities and additional options provided by SWALCO. Please contact SWALCO at **847.336.9340**.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Yard waste season is April 1st through November 30th of each year. LRS will collect yard waste material on the same day as garbage and recycle. All items must be placed out for collection by 7 AM. Residents can use stickers or enroll in the subscription program with a provided LRS cart.



WHAT IS CONSIDERED YARD WASTE?

Yard waste, also known as landscape waste, consists of organic waste materials accumulated as the result of cultivation and maintenance of gardens, lawns, shrubbery, trees, and vines.

Organic Food Scrap may be mixed in with yard waste April through November.

Organic Food Scraps Accepted: bread, cereal, coffee grounds, dairy, eggshells, eggs, fruits, grain, pasta, shells, and vegetables

Unacceptable materials: sod, dirt, artificial Christmas trees, wreath greenery, garland (not considered yard waste)

YARD WASTE AND FOOD SCRAP COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Use minimum 2-ply biodegradable landscape waste, paper bags not to exceed 50 lbs.
- Biodegradable bags may be used not to exceed 34 gallons, 50 lbs., when full
- Resident-owned containers may be used but are subject to the cart lift mechanism which may damage retail store brand containers
 - » Resident-owned containers may not exceed 34 gallons and not exceed 50lbs when full
 - » Must be marked with large "YW" or "YARD WASTE"
- Tie brush bundles with biodegradable string or twine. Bundles must not exceed 4' long, 2' wide & 50 lbs.

Each bundle, pile, bag or non-LRS yard waste container requires one (1) sticker per bundle, pile, bag or container.

RENT LRS YARD WASTE / FOOD SCRAP CART ON WHEELS WITH FLIP TOP LID (no sticker needed for anything inside the cart)

- 95-gallon cart subscription - \$200.00/year

To enroll in subscription yard waste, please contact LRS customer service or submit a request during enrollment period.

KILDEER LRS RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE / YARD WASTE STICKER

The Village of Kildeer LRS residential garbage and yard waste sticker can be used on additional loose bags or cans, yard waste/organics. The stickers are available for purchase at Kildeer Village Hall beginning in late June.

Please be aware, LRS will not accept WM stickers at the start of service on July 1st, 2023.

Please read each section to find out how many stickers are required for items placed out for collection.
