#### LRS YARD WASTE GUIDELINES

**LRS Provided Container:** Items contained in 35-gallon, 64-gallon or 96-gallon cart **Personal Container:** 35-gallon customer-owned container (50 lb. limit) marked with an X or YW **Disposable Container:** 30-gallon biodegradable, 2-ply thickness, landscape waste bag (50 lb. limit) **Bundles:** Secured in a 4 ft. by 4 ft. tied bundle of brush or branches no larger than 2 ft. in diameter

Yard Waste collection is seasonal, on your regular service day. Leaf collection and organics may be included or offered as separate services depending on the program. Program details vary by location.
